Born and raised in Brooklyn NY, the son of Callie and Nancy Whitmore, he was a lifelong resident of Brooklyn until he retired and moved to Marietta Georgia.

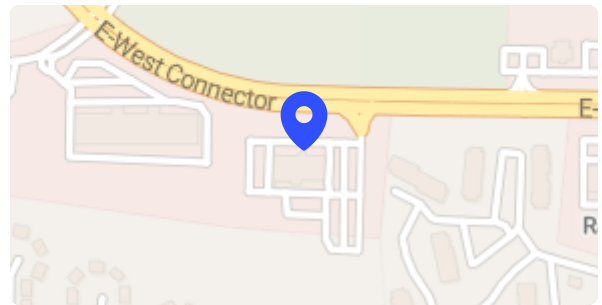

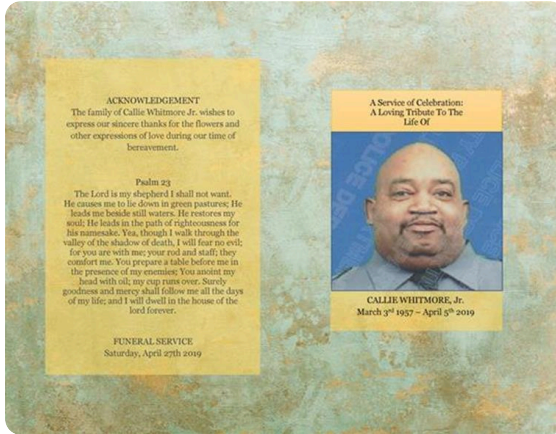

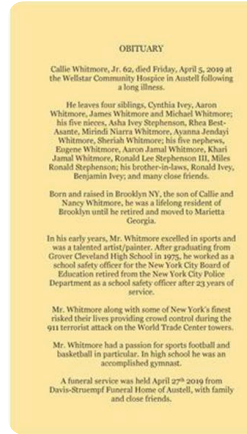
