Three grandchildren.

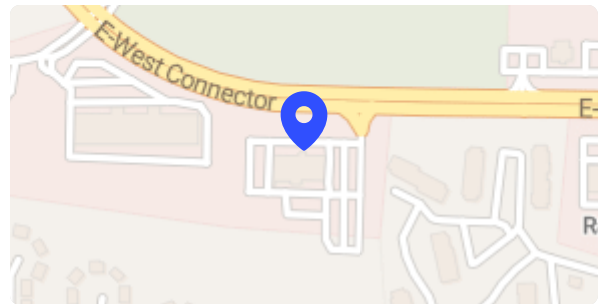

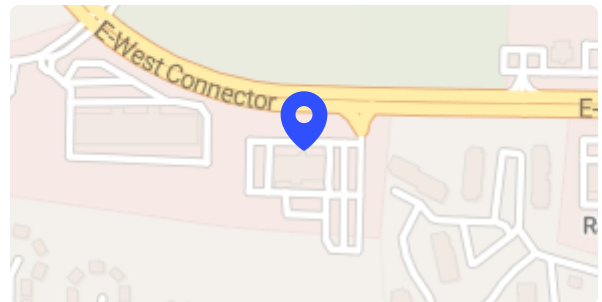
