The much beloved William Henry (Bill) Howard passed away at age 80 on Sunday July 8, 2012, at his home in Austell in the presence of his devoted wife of 57 years, Ruth Powell Howard. 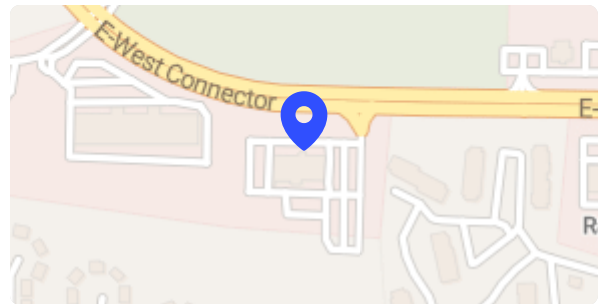

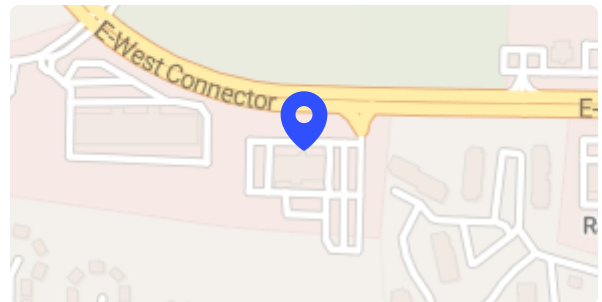
