A graveside service will be held Thursday, April 1st, 1:00 PM at Parkhill Cemetery in Columbus, GA with Dr. Farren Roper officiating.

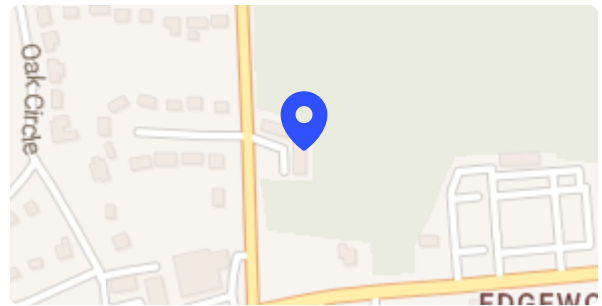

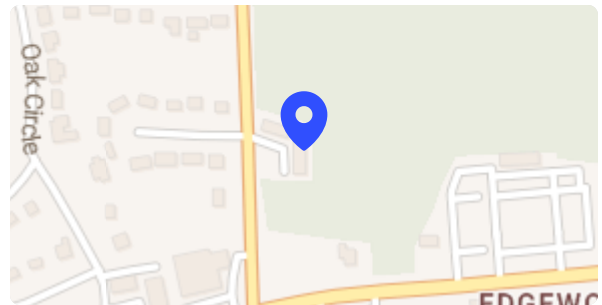
