allow time for shared stories and tributes. Due to occupancy limitations and health concerns in these trying times, this event is limited to family and close friends.

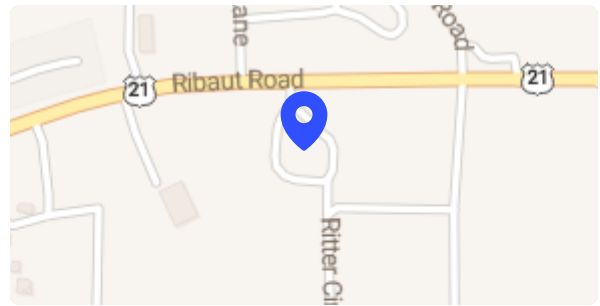
