John (Jack) Green Mitchell passed away on September 6, 2022.

He was born on May 15, 1931 in Atlanta (Sylvan Hills), Georgia, the son of Bernice and John Mitchell. Jack graduated from Boys High School in Atlanta, and then went on to serve in the United States Air Force during the Korean War. Following military service, he returned home and began his university education at The Atlanta Division of the University of Georgia (now Georgia State) to become a CPA. He initially worked for the IRS and public accounting firms in Albany and Cordele Georgia, before opening his own firm in downtown Atlanta. 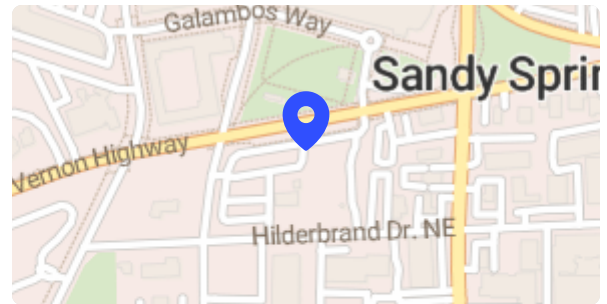

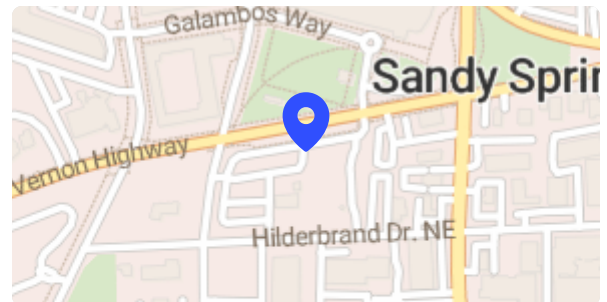
