**B**etty Lee Greer, age 89, of Mableton passed away February 12, 2023. She loved the kids on her routes and retired from driving after 50 years of service. In later years, she enjoyed going on adventures with her son, Danny, in his motorhome. She loved it so much that she threatened to sell her house and live exclusively in the RV.
