In lieu of flowers, the family requests donations be made to The American Lung Association or the Alzheimer’s Association.

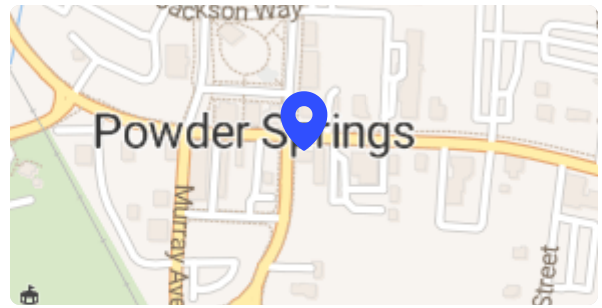
