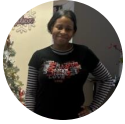

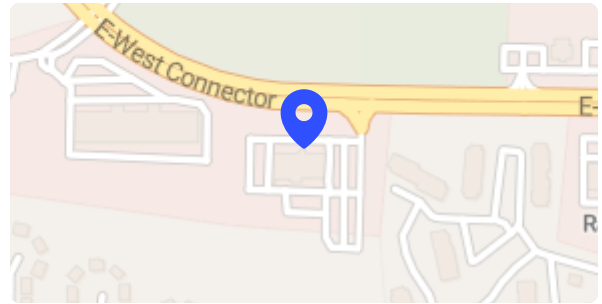

The family will receive friends from 12:00 to 2:00 PM before the service.



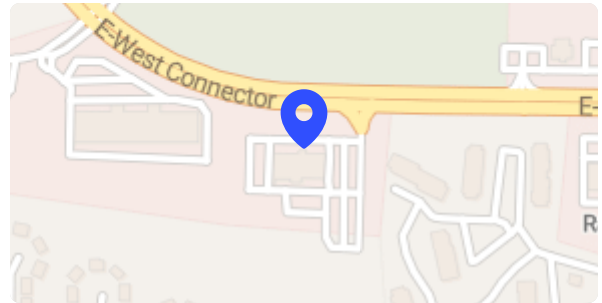
