The family will receive friends from 1:00 PM to 2:00 PM before the service.






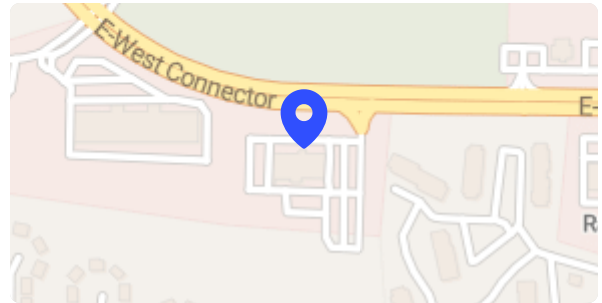
