and Robby Wade; nieces and nephews, David, Daniel, Timothy, Hannah Davidson, Lilly Martinez; sister-in-law, April Koos.

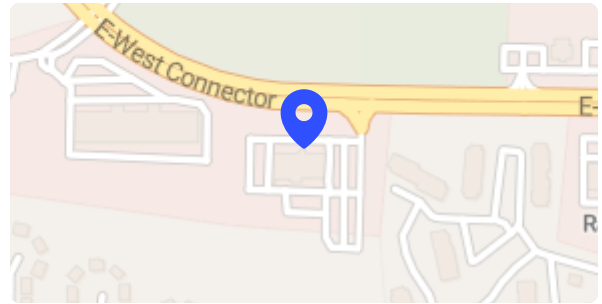

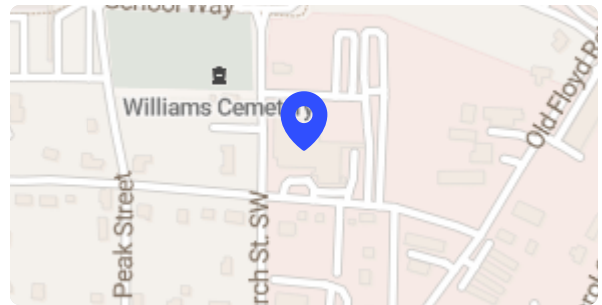

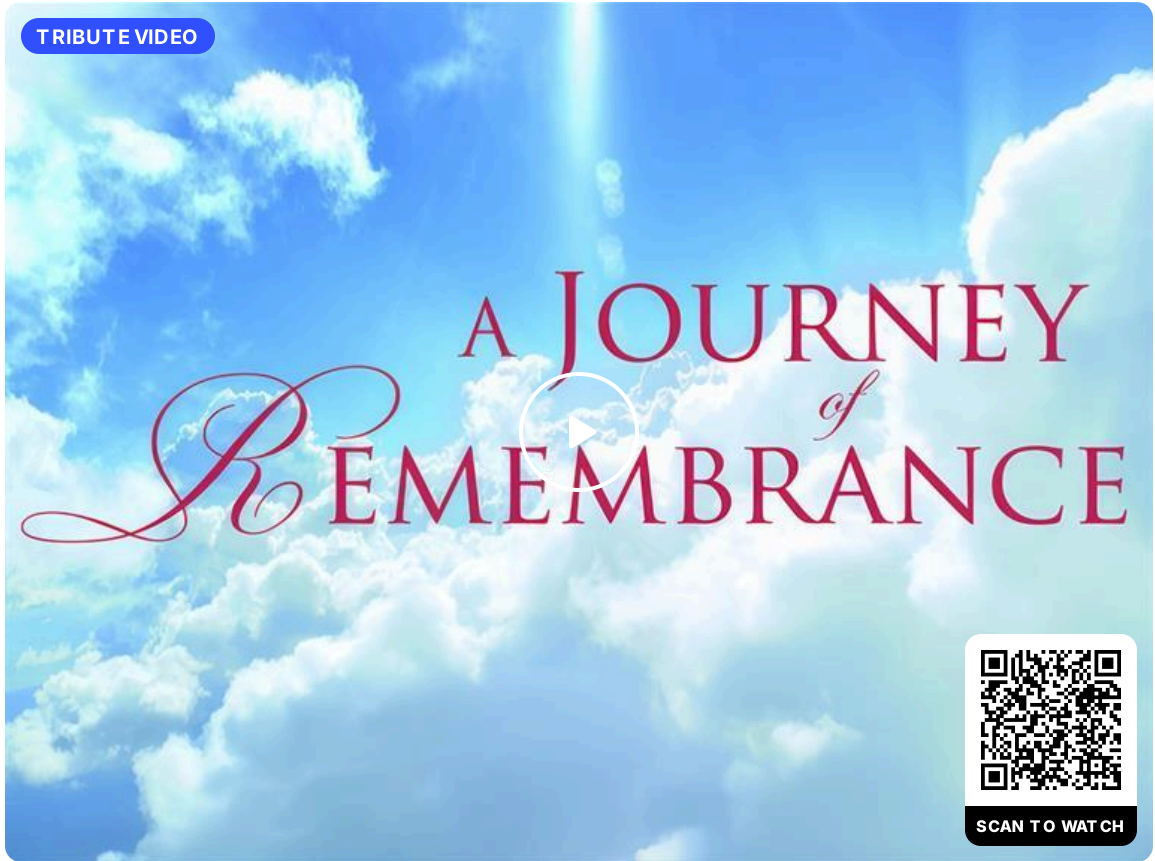
