A Visitation will be held on Wednesday, October 29, 2025, from 5:00 PM- 7:00 PM at Davis-Struempf Funeral Home.






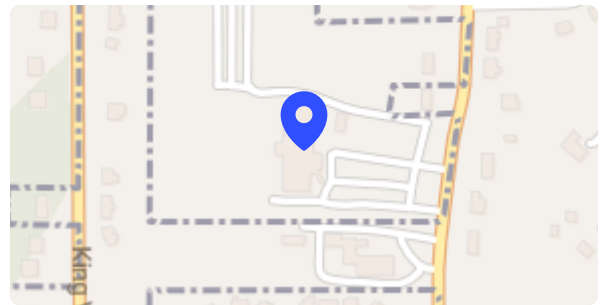
