Richie was born in Macon, Georgia, on February 15th, 1963. His father was owner of Bosworth and Associates Insurance agency, and his mother was a very dedicated stay at home Mom. He attended and graduated from Gilead Christian Academy as the Salutatorian of his class in 1981.
