A service will be held on Friday, February 6, 2026, at 4:00 p.m. at Shiloh Gardens in Cumming, Georgia.

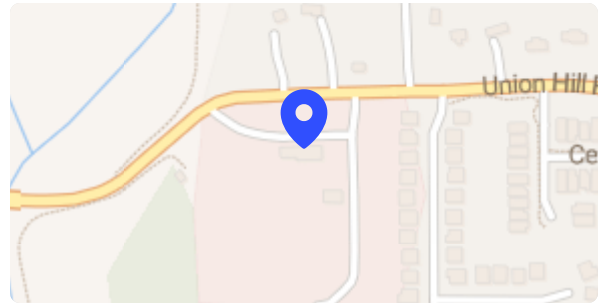

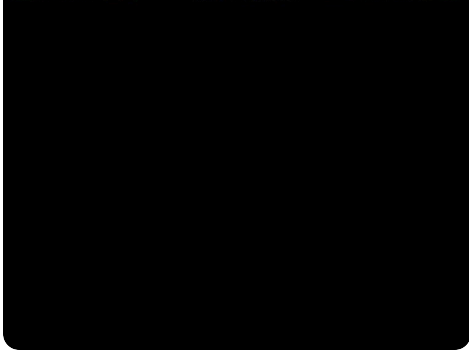
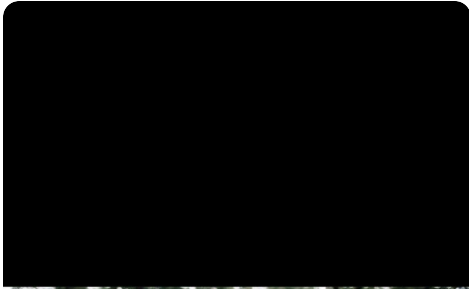
