Asegid "Ace" Ayalew, age 48, of Mableton died Sunday, March 3, 2013. The funeral service will be held Saturday, March 16th 1:00PM at Davis-Struempf Chapel. Burial will be at Mt. There are no words to describe how his untimely death will affect us all. We are only left with the memories of times spent with him and we promise to keep him alive in our hearts.



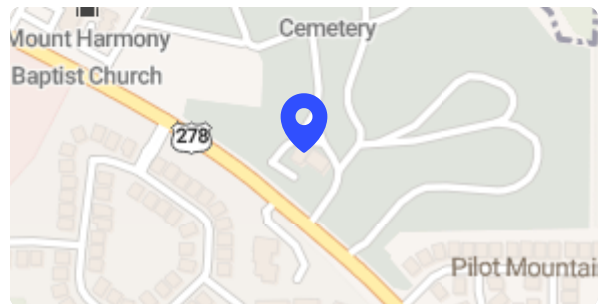
