



## Claude Wood Pollard

Mr. Claude Wood Pollard, age 81, of Mableton, GA passed away Friday May 1, 2015. Mr. Pollard is survived by his wife, Jo Bivins Pollard, son David Pollard, and brother Clyde Pollard. He was predeceased by his sister, Edna Pollard Marlow and three brothers, Byron Pollard, Billy Pollard, and Robert Pollard.

Mr. Pollard was born August 24, 1933 in Temple, GA, the son of Ollie Robert Pollard and Helen Wood Pollard.

Mr. Pollard served in the United States Air Force from 1952-1955 and the United States Navy from 1955-1974. He was the recipient of the National Defense Service Medal for service in the Korean War and Vietnam War. He also received multiple Good Conduct Medals during his service. Mr. Pollard retired from active duty military service in 1974 and transitioned to civil service work in Norfolk, VA and Atlanta, GA until his retirement in 1995. He was dedicated to his career and was consistently recognized by his peers for his superior performance.

Mr. Pollard was an avid golfer, he also enjoyed running, lifting weights, and gardening. He was a member of Macland Road Baptist Church in Powder Springs, GA and was baptized in 1980 at Burrows Baptist Church in Norfolk, VA. He was a faithful and loving husband of 47 years, a perfect role model as a father for 45 years, and a friend to many. He always had a pleasant demeanor and was a positive influence on the life of anyone he came in contact with. He lived a full, happy life and he will be missed tremendously.
