Mrs. Horne loved planting flowers...especially roses & tulips. She loved quilting, cooking, canning, crochet, antiquing and talking with her best friends. In her latter years, she was especially fond of reminiscing with her beloved brother Rogers Bennett about the good old days. She loved eating the delicious chicken dumplings, greens & pound cake her Sister

Jessie cooked for her.

She had a deep desire to trust in the Lord and count her blessings. Even though strokes robbed her of her vision and ability to walk she thanked God for waking up each morning. Her home was always open to family and friends.
